Section 1. Subsection (6) of section 581.011, Florida Statutes, is amended, subsections (15) through (29) are renumbered as subsections (17) through (31), respectively, and new subsections (15) and (16) are added to said section, to read:

581.011 Definitions.--As used in this chapter:

- (6) "Certificate of registration" means an official document issued by the division to nurseries, stock dealers, agents, and plant brokers, and landscape designers as evidence of being properly registered with the division in compliance with the requirements of this chapter and of any of the rules promulgated hereunder.
- (15) "Landscape design" means the planning, design, or construction of exterior spaces, using plant materials and incidental paving and building materials, and includes any consultation with respect such planning, design, or construction.
- (16) "Landscape designer" means a person who, for compensation, provides or offers to provide any landscape design service.

Section 2. Subsections (8), (11), and (21) of section 581.031, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

- 581.031 Department; powers and duties.--The department has the following powers and duties:
- (8)(a) To make and publish reasonable rules governing the application for, and issuance, suspension, and revocation of, certificates of registration and of inspection of nurserymen, stock dealers, agents, and plant brokers in the state.
- (b) To make such rules as are necessary for the issuance and renewal of certificates of registration of

landscape designers and to charge fees for the issuance and renewal of such certificates which are sufficient to pay the costs of issuance, renewal, and discipline of such certificates, not to exceed \$100 for initial issuance or renewal.

- (11) To suspend or revoke certificates of inspection and of registration of nurserymen, stock dealers, agents, and plant brokers, and landscape designers in the state.
- (21)(a) To make and issue certificates of registration and of inspection to nurserymen, stock dealers, agents, and plant brokers, after proper certification of their nursery stock, authorizing them to do business as nurserymen, stock dealers, agents, or plant brokers within the state.
- (b) To make and issue certificates of registration to landscape designers authorizing them to do business as landscape designers within the state.

Section 3. Section 581.035, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

581.035 Preemption of regulatory authority over nurseries and landscape designers.—It is the intent of the Legislature to eliminate duplication of regulatory authority over nurseries and landscape designers. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the authority to regulate, inspect, and permit:

- (1) Nursery owners, plant brokers, and stock dealers; $\frac{1}{1}$
- (2) Nurseries, nursery stock, plants, and plant products, including any aquatic plant as defined in s. 369.22 which is grown in a nursery; and
 - (3) Landscape designers,

is preempted to the department.

Section 4. Section 581.121, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

581.121 Nursery stock; prohibited conduct.--It is unlawful for any nurseryman, stock dealer, agent, or plant broker, or landscape designer to sell, give away, transfer, move or cause to be moved, carry, ship, or deliver for carriage or shipment any nursery stock except in compliance with the provisions of this chapter and the rules made pursuant to law.

Section 5. Subsection (9) of section 581.131, Florida Statutes, is amended, and subsection (11) is added to said section, to read:

581.131 Certificate of registration.--

- (9)(a) If the registration has not been renewed or the fee has not been paid by the renewal date, a penalty of \$10 or 20 percent of the renewal fee, whichever is greater, shall be assessed.
- (b) If the registration has not been renewed or the fee has not been paid within 31 days of the renewal date, the department shall stop sale or stop movement on all nursery stock until the person has renewed the certificate of registration.
- (c) If the registration has not been renewed or the fee has not been paid within 31 days of the renewal date, the landscape designer shall stop providing any landscape design services until she or he has renewed the certificate of registration.
- $\underline{\text{(d)}\text{(c)}}$ Upon application prior to the renewal date, the department may, for good cause supported by written

 documentation, extend the renewal date without penalty for up to 90 days.

- any landscape design service in this state, she or he shall apply to the director of the division, on forms supplied by the division, for a certificate of registration. The application and renewal process shall be as provided in this section and by department rule.
- (b) The department shall provide qualifications for registration by rule, according to the following minimum criteria:
- 1. Completion of a bachelor's degree in ornamental horticulture, landscape design and management, or a related field from an accredited university;
- 2. Completion of an associate in science or arts

 degree in landscape design, horticulture, landscape

 management, or a related field from an accredited community

 college, together with 2 years' full-time documented

 experience in landscape design;
- 3. Completion of a 1-year certificate in ornamental horticulture, landscape management, or a related field from an accredited technical center, together with 4 years' full-time documented experience in landscape design;
- 4. Completion of 6 years' full-time practical experience in landscape design; or
- <u>5. Certification by a nationally recognized</u> organization in landscape design.
- (c) Neither the certificate of registration fee nor the annual renewal fee may exceed \$100.
- 30 (d) The department may exempt from payment of a
 31 certificate fee those governmental agencies whose landscape

design services are provided exclusively for landscaping designs on their own property.

(e) This subsection does not apply to architects registered under part I of chapter 481; landscape architects registered under part II of chapter 481; engineers registered under chapter 471; contractors licensed under chapter 489 for work on their own property; arborists, including tree trimming and tree removal services; tree moving services; and lawn maintenance services or landscape maintenance services for the provision of maintenance services.

Section 6. Section 581.141, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

581.141 Certificate of registration or of inspection; revocation and suspension; fines.--

(1) REVOCATION AND SUSPENSION. -- If it is determined by the department that any nurseryman, stock dealer, agent, or plant broker is selling or offering for sale, or is distributing or offering to distribute, nursery stock or that any landscape designer is providing landscape design services in violation of the provisions of this chapter and the rules adopted under this chapter, or has aided or abetted in such violation, the department may revoke or suspend her or his certificate of registration or the use of any certificates, permits, or agreements issued by the division. Further, the department may refuse or suspend the certification of any nursery stock or plant product when it is determined that plant pests exist on the stock or product or that the nursery or site is in such condition with regard to growth and cultivation that an efficient inspection for plant pests cannot be made.

(2) FINES; PROBATION. --

- (a)1. The department may, after notice and hearing, impose a fine not exceeding \$5,000 or probation not exceeding 12 months, or both, for the violation of any of the provisions of this chapter or the rules adopted under this chapter upon any person, nurseryman, stock dealer, agent, or plant broker, or landscape designer. The fine, when paid, shall be deposited in the Plant Industry Trust Fund.
- 2. The imposition of a fine or probation pursuant to this subsection may be in addition to or in lieu of the suspension or revocation of a certificate of registration or certificate of inspection.
- (b) Whenever any administrative order has been made and entered by the department imposing a fine upon any person pursuant to this subsection, the order shall specify the amount of the fine and the time limit for payment, which shall not exceed 15 days. Upon failure to pay the fine within such time, the certificate of registration or certificate of inspection of the person may be suspended or revoked without further hearing; and a fine of \$100 per day may be imposed for each day the violation continues.

Section 7. Paragraph (a) of subsection (3) of section 581.211, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

581.211 Penalties for violations.--

(3)(a)1. In addition to any other provision of law, the department may, after notice and hearing, impose an administrative fine not exceeding \$5,000 for each violation of this chapter, upon any person, nurseryman, stock dealer, agent, or plant broker, or landscape designer. The fine, when paid, shall be deposited in the Plant Industry Trust Fund. In addition, the department may place the violator on probation for up to 1 year, with conditions.

The imposition of a fine or probation pursuant to this subsection may be in addition to or in lieu of the suspension or revocation of a certificate of registration or certificate of inspection.

Section 8. Subsection (5) of section 481.329, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

481.329 Exceptions; exemptions from licensure.--

(5) This part shall not be deemed to prohibit any nurseryman, nursery stock dealer, or landscape designer as defined by chapter 581 who is required under chapter 581 to hold a valid certificate of registration license issued by the Division of Plant Industry of the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services and who does hold a valid certificate of registration license to engage in the business of selling nursery stock or providing landscape design services in this state, insofar as she or he engages in the preparation of plans or drawings as an adjunct to merchandising her or his product, so long as she or he does not use the title, term, or designation "landscape architect," "landscape architectural," "landscape architecture," "L.A.," "landscape engineering," or any description tending to convey the impression that she or he is a landscape architect unless she or he is registered as provided in this part or is exempt from registration under the provisions of this part.

Section 9. This act shall take effect October 1 of the year in which enacted.

HOUSE SUMMARY Provides for regulation of landscape designers under ch. 581, F.S., relating to the plant industry. Preempts authority over landscape designers to the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services and provides the department with the requisite powers and duties and rulemaking authority therefor. Requires registration and provides for discipline of landscape designers.
