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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Section 447.303, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

447.303 Dues; deduction and collection. -- Any employee organization which has been certified as a bargaining agent shall have the right to have its dues and uniform assessments deducted and collected by the employer from the salaries of those employees who authorize the deduction of said dues and uniform assessments. However, such authorization is revocable at the employee's request upon 30 days' written notice to the employer and employee organization. Said deductions shall commence upon the bargaining agent's written request to the The employer shall not grant a dues deduction to employer. any other employee organization, except a religious institution or qualified charitable institution under s. 501(c)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, provided such institutions do not represent, or attempt to represent, bargaining unit members in terms and conditions of employment. Reasonable costs to the employer of said deductions shall be a proper subject of collective bargaining. Such right to deduction, unless revoked pursuant to s. 447.507, shall be in force for so long as the employee

organization remains the certified bargaining agent for the employees in the unit. The public employer is expressly prohibited from any involvement in the collection of fines, penalties, or special assessments. Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1 of the year in which enacted. HOUSE SUMMARY Limits employer deductions of dues of employee organizations to those organizations certified as bargaining agents and religious or charitable institutions which do not represent bargaining unit members in terms and conditions of employment.
