An act relating to North Bay Fire Control District, Okaloosa County; recreating and reenacting the North Bay Fire Control District as an independent fire control district operating pursuant to the terms of chapter 191, Florida Statutes; describing the boundaries of said district; establishing a governing body for the district; authorizing the district to levy up to 2 mills of ad valorem tax as previously approved by referendum vote; providing severability; providing an effective date.

Section 1. The North Bay Fire Control District is recreated and reenacted to read:

Section 1. Creation and intent. -- Upon this act becoming law, the North Bay Fire Control District, formerly known as the Seminole Fire District, shall be recreated as an independent fire control district which shall operate pursuant to this special act and the provisions of chapter 191, Florida Statutes, the Independent Special Fire Control District Act, as it may be amended from time to time, and all other general law applicable to independent special districts. It is the intent of this act to preserve all existing district authority as it may be modified pursuant to the provisions of chapter 191, Florida Statutes, including the authority to annually assess and levy against the taxable property in the district a tax not to exceed 2 mills on the dollar of assessed valuation.

Section 2. Boundaries. -- The following area in Okaloosa 1 2 County shall be established as the independent fire control 3 district known as the North Bay Fire Control District: 4 That land area lying in Township 1 South, Range 5 22 West, bounded on the north by Rocky Bayou 6 and Eglin Air Force Base Reservation, bounded 7 on the west and south by Choctawhatchee Bay and bounded on the east by the Walton County line 8 9 and Eglin Air Force Base Reservation. Section 3. Taxing authority.--10 (1) The board of fire commissioners is hereby 11 12 authorized to levy and impose an ad valorem tax for fire protection services provided by the district in an amount not 13 14 in excess of 2 mills on the dollar against the nonexempt assessed value of property in the district as previously 15 approved by referendum vote of the electors of the district. 16 17 (2) The aforementioned ad valorem taxes shall be levied and imposed by the board of fire commissioners pursuant 18 19 to the provisions of chapter 191, Florida Statutes, and shall 20 be assessed, levied, and collected in the same manner as 21 county taxes. Section 4. Construction. -- The provisions of this act 22 23 shall be liberally construed in order to effectively carry out the purposes of this act in the interest of the public health, 24 25 welfare, and safety of the citizens served by the district. 26 Section 2. It is declared to be the intent of the Legislature that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, 27 28 phrase, or portion of this act is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, 29 30 such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and 31
