Upon notification of the presence of a sexual predator, the sheriff 20 of the county or the chief of police of the municipality where 21 22 the sexual predator temporarily or permanently resides shall 23 notify the community and the public of the presence of the sexual predator in a manner deemed appropriate by the sheriff 24 or the chief of police. Within 48 hours after receiving 25 26 notification of the presence of a sexual predator, the sheriff of the county or the chief of police of the municipality where 27 the sexual predator temporarily or permanently resides shall 28 29 notify each licensed day care center, elementary school, middle school, and high school within a 1-mile radius of the 30 temporary or permanent residence of the sexual predator of the 31 1

presence of the sexual predator. Information provided to the 1 2 community and the public regarding a sexual predator must 3 include: 4 1. The name of the sexual predator; 5 2. A description of the sexual predator, including a 6 photograph; 7 3. The sexual predator's current address, including 8 the name of the county or municipality if known; 9 4. The circumstances of the sexual predator's offense or offenses; and 10 5. Whether the victim of the sexual predator's offense 11 12 or offenses was, at the time of the offense, a minor or an 13 adult. 14 15 This paragraph does not authorize the release of the name of 16 any victim of the sexual predator. 17 (c) The department shall notify the public of all 18 designated sexual predators through the Internet. The 19 Internet notice shall include the information required by 20 paragraph (a). 21 Section 2.
