17	<u>(13) If the department and a local government</u>		
18	<u>independently require financial assurance for the closure of a</u>		
19	<u>privately owned solid-waste-management facility, the</u>		
20	<u>department and that local government shall enter into an</u>		
21	<u>interagency agreement that will allow the owner or operator to</u>		
22	<u>provide a single financial mechanism to cover the costs of</u>		
23	<u>closure and any required long-term care. The financial</u>		
24	<u>mechanism may provide for the department and local government</u>		
25	<u>to be cobeneficiaries or copayees, but shall not impose</u>		
26	<u>duplicative financial requirements on the owner or operator.</u>		
27	<u>These closure costs must include at least the minimum required</u>		
28	<u>by department rules and must also include any additional costs</u>		
29	<u>required by local ordinance or regulation.</u>
