Chapter 20715, Laws of Florida, 1941, and 16 17 chapter 24323, Laws of Florida, 1947, relating to the Zellwood 18 Drainage and Water Control District are repealed and the Zellwood Drainage and Water Control District shall be 19 dissolved effective September 30, 1998, provided all lands 20 within the district boundaries have been purchased or 21 otherwise acquired by the St. Johns River Water Management 22 23 District pursuant to s. 373.461, Florida Statutes, as of that date. In the event all lands within the district have not been 24 purchased or otherwise acquired by September 30, 1998, chapter 25 26 20715, Laws of Florida, 1941, and chapter 24323, Laws of 27 Florida, 1947, shall not be repealed and the district shall 28 not be dissolved. 29 Section 2. On or before September 30, 1998, St. Johns 30 River Water Management District and the Zellwood Drainage and
