25	and public areas immediately adjacent to county parks, and
26	which are either prohibited by ordinance enacted by the Board
27	of County Commissioners of Collier County or are specifically
28	prohibited by this section. It shall be such an offense to:
29	(g) Cause or permit a dog or other domestic animal to

rules of the department that have been approved by the board of county commissioners. (h) Build fires except in specified areas in county parks on cooking grills provided therein, except bonfires directly related to special events may be authorized by the director of the department on a case-by-case basis as then authorized by rules of the department approved by the board of county commissioners. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
