A bill to be entitled An act relating to education; establishing a study commission to determine the feasibility of creating a residential mathematics and sciences academy; providing for the commission's membership and duties; requiring a report; providing an appropriation; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. (1) There is established the Mathematics and Sciences Study Commission to determine the feasibility of creating a public-private, residential, coeducational academy offering an advanced curriculum in mathematics and sciences for students in grades 11 and 12 using the $K-16$ philosophy to prepare students for professional careers in this state. The commission shall select a private partner, a State University System partner, the locale, and the estimated operating cost for the academy.
(2) Members of the commission shall be appointed as follows:
(a) The Governor shall appoint five members, including a math or science teacher, a member of the Enterprise Florida Board of Directors, a principal or administrator of a state public school, a member of the Board of Regents, and a member of the Florida Commission on Education Reform and Accountability.
(b) The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall each appoint a member of the

majority party and a member of the minority party of their
respective houses.
(c) The Commissioner of Education shall appoint five
members, including a math or science teacher, a member of the
Enterprise Florida Board of Directors, a member of the Florida
School Board Administrators Association, and a member of the
Postsecondary Education Planning Commission.
(3) The commission shall be staffed by the
Postsecondary Education Planning Commission and the Florida
Commission on Education Reform and Accountability. Regular
meetings may be held for 2 days each month and at such other
times as the commission deems necessary, after all members
have been appointed.
(4) Commission members and staff shall receive
reimbursement for per diem and travel expenses incurred in the
performance of their duties, as provided in s. 112.061,
Florida Statutes.
(5) The commission shall present its findings and
recommendations to the Governor, the President of the Senate,
the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the
Commissioner of Education by January 1, 1999, at which time
the commission shall be terminated.
Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from General
Revenue, the sum of $\$ 75,000$ for the Mathematics and Science
Study Commission.
Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
law.
