The fire and rescue districts in Collier County, the Big Corkscrew Island Fire Control and Rescue 11 12 District, the East Naples Fire Control and Rescue District, 13 the Golden Gate Fire Control and Rescue District, the North 14 Naples Fire Control and Rescue District, and the Immokalee Fire Control and Rescue District, may, pursuant to the 15 provisions of s. 191.005(1)(a), Florida Statutes, and this 16 17 act, be governed by a three-member board if proposed by resolution of the governing board of a district adopted no 18 19 later than 30 days from the passage of this act and approved 20 by vote of the electors of the district in a referendum to be held at the same time as the first primary election in 1998. 21 22 The ballot question shall read: 23 24 The governing board of the proposes that the district continue to be 25 26 governed by a three-member governing board. If approved by the electorate, the governing board 27 28 will have three members and seats will be 29 open on the 1998 general election ballot. If not approved, the governing board will have 30

13	election. Elections held for the governing board after the
14	1998 general election shall be in accordance with the terms of
15	s. 191.005, Florida Statutes.
16	Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
17	law.
