An act relating to a special election to be held on September 1, 1998, pursuant to Section 5 of Article XI of the State Constitution, for the approval or rejection by the electors of Florida of a joint resolution amending Section 17 of Article I of the State Constitution relating to the death penalty and interpretation of the term "cruel or unusual punishment"; providing for publication of notice and for procedures; providing an effective date.

A bill to be entitled

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 5 of Article XI of the State Constitution, there shall be a special election on September 1, 1998, at which there shall be submitted to the electors of Florida for approval or rejection House Joint Resolution No. 3505 proposing the amendment of Section 17 of Article I of the State Constitution, which amendment preserves the death penalty and provides for certain interpretations of the term "cruel or unusual punishment."

Section 2. Publication of notice shall be in accordance with Section 5 of Article XI of the State Constitution. The special election shall be held as other special elections are held.

 Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, if passed by a vote of three-fourths of the membership of each house.
