Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 1, lines 13-18, delete those lines

and insert: and a body corporate and politic, may, pursuant to the provisions of s. 191.005(1)(a), Florida Statutes, and this act, be governed by a three-member board if proposed by resolution of the governing board of a district adopted no later than 30 days after the effective date of this act and approved by vote of the electors of the district in a referendum to be held at the same time as the first primary election in 1998. The ballot question shall read:

The governing board of the _____ District proposes that the district continue to be governed by a three-member governing board. If approved by the electorate, the governing board will have three members and _____ seats will be open on the 1998 general election ballot. If not approved, the governing board will have
