HOUSE SUMMARY Provides exemptions from the provisions of law governing driver license restrictions which are applied to a person who holds a driver's license and who is under 17 years of age when operating a motor vehicle after 11 p.m. and before 6 a.m., and applied to a person who is 17 years of age when driving after 1 a.m. and before 5 a.m., if the person maintains a weighted grade point average of 3.0 or better or has earned a high school diploma or its equivalent.
