21	defibrillator technology have resulted in the availability of

23	effective in treating sudden cardiac arrest, and
24	WHEREAS, these new devices are virtually
25	maintenance-free, safe and easy to use with minimum training,
26	small, lightweight, durable, and less expensive, and
27	WHEREAS, the widespread availability of these new
28	devices will make sudden cardiac arrest a truly treatable
29	disease, preventing hundreds of unnecessary deaths, and
30	WHEREAS, the Legislature has determined that it is in
