Subsection (4) of section 514.011, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 15 16 514.011 Definitions.--As used in this chapter: "Public bathing place" means a body of water, 17 (4) natural or modified by humans, for swimming, diving, and 18 recreational bathing, together with adjacent shoreline or land 19 20 area, buildings, equipment, and appurtenances pertaining 21 thereto, used by consent of the owner or owners and held out 22 to the public by any person or public body, irrespective of whether a fee is charged for the use thereof. The bathing 23 water areas of public bathing places include, but are not 24 25 limited to, lakes, ponds, rivers, streams, and artificial 26 impoundments, and waters along the coastal and intracoastal 27 beaches and shores of the state. 28 Section 2. 1 The department is authorized to adopt and enforce (1) 2 rules to protect the health, safety, and welfare of persons 3 using the beach waters of the state. The rules shall establish health standards and prescribe procedures and timeframes for 4 5 bacteriological sampling of beach waters. (2) The department may issue health advisories if the 6 7 quality of beach waters fails to meet standards established by 8 the department. The issuance of health advisories related to 9 the results of bacteriological sampling of beach waters is 10 hereby preempted to the state. 11 (3) For purposes of this section, "beach waters" means 12 the waters along the coastal and intracoastal beaches and 13 shores of the state, and includes saltwater and brackish 14 water. Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 15 16 law. 17 18 19 HOUSE SUMMARY 20 Modifies the definition of "public bathing place," in provisions authorizing regulation of such places by the Department of Health, to include the waters along the coastal and intracoastal beaches and shores of the state. Authorizes the department to sample such waters and to issue health advisories if such waters fail to meet health standards developed by the department.
