Senator Silver moved the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 7, line 13,

insert:

Section 2. A total of \$1,063,900 in recurring General Revenue Funds is appropriated in Special Categories - Grants and Aids - Contracted Services in the Department of Juvenile Justice for D-FY-IT Drug Free Youth in Town, a drug prevention program for youth in schools, and for Miami Love Youth At Risk Program, a prevention program for youth at risk of delinquent behavior, and for Grants in Aid to local governments and nonprofit organizations - Uleta Park Community Center.

Section 3. The sum of \$200,000 is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Elderly Affairs for the provision of essential home health care services to senior citizens in Dade County by United Home Health Care, a not-for-profit corporation. This is a nonrecurring appropriation for fiscal year 1998-1999.

Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 1998.
