HOUSE SUMMARY With respect to special requirements for compensability under the Workers' Compensation Law, provides that an injury suffered by any employed or appointed full-time, part-time, or auxiliary law enforcement officer, correctional officer, or correctional probation officer who is going to or coming from work in an official law enforcement or corrections vehicle shall be deemed to be an injury arising out of and in the course of employment an injury arising out of and in the course of employment.
