

shall be based on the latest official Florida Crime Index 1 2 provided by the Department of Law Enforcement and one-third shall be based on each district's share of the state's total 3 4 weighted school enrollment. Safe Schools activities include 1) after school programs for middle school students; (2) 5 other improvements to enhance the learning, environment, 6 7 including implementation of conflict resolution strategies; 8 and (3) alternative school programs for adjudicated youth. Each district shall determine, based on a review of its 9 10 existing programs and priorities, how much of its total 11 allocation to use for each authorized Safe Schools activity. 12 Section 30.
