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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Subsection (4) of section 3 of chapter 76-414, Laws of Florida, as amended by chapter 91-398, Laws of Florida, is amended to read:

Section 3. (4) The board may employ such personnel as it deems necessary for the proper function and operation of the a fire and rescue department and establish and maintain emergency medical services and acquire and maintain rescue, medical, and other emergency equipment pursuant to the provisions of chapter 401, Florida Statutes, and any certificate of public convenience and necessity or its equivalent issued thereunder.

Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 4 of chapter 76-414, Laws of Florida, is amended to read:

30 31 Section 4. (1) The commissioners, immediately upon their appointment as herein provided, or within 10 days thereafter and annually in <u>January November</u>, shall organize by electing from their number, a chairman, vice-chairman, a secretary and a treasurer. However, the same member may be both secretary and treasurer.

Section 3. Section 5 of chapter 76-414, Laws of Florida, as amended by chapter 87-422, Laws of Florida, is amended to read:

Section 5. (1) The board shall have the right, power, and authority to levy millage tax against the taxable real estate within the district to provide funds for the purpose of this district.

- (2) The tax rate shall be fixed by a resolution of the board following public hearings of the proposed budget as provided in section 6. However, the tax shall not exceed \$3.00\frac{\$2.50}{} per 1,000 of net taxable assessed valuation.
- (3) It is the legislative intent that this act will authorize the Lee County property appraiser and the Lee County tax collector to take all appropriate action to comply with the intent and purpose of this act.

Section 4. Section 3 of this act shall take effect only upon its approval by a majority vote of those qualified electors of the Bayshore Fire Protection and Rescue Service District voting in a referendum election to be called by the Board of Commissioners of Bayshore Fire Protection and Rescue Service District and to be held in conjunction with a primary or general election, in accordance with the provisions of law relating to elections currently in force.

Section 5. Subsection (4) of section 11 of chapter 76-414, Laws of Florida, is amended to read:

Section 11. (4) The board shall, in accordance with the provisions of chapter 189, Laws of Florida on or before November 1, make an annual report of its actions and accounting of its funds as of September 30 and shall file said report in the office of the Clerk of Circuit Court of Lee County, whose duty it shall be to receive and file said report and hold and keep the same as a public record. Section 6. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
