14	On page 2, lines 11 through 21, delete those lines

17	<u>(2) Equipment, machinery, or materials required to</u>		
18	<u>meet any law implemented by, or any condition of a permit</u>		
19	<u>issued by, the Department of Environmental Protection which</u>		
20	<u>are purchased for the monitoring, prevention, abatement, or</u>		
21	<u>control of pollution or contaminants at privately owned and</u>		
22	<u>operated landfills or construction and demolition debris</u>		
23	<u>disposal facilities shall be exempt from taxation as otherwise</u>		
24	<u>imposed by this chapter; however, such exemption shall not be</u>		
25	<u>allowed unless the purchaser signs a certificate stating that</u>		
26	<u>the equipment, machinery, or materials to be exempted are</u>		
27	<u>required to meet such law or condition. This exemption does</u>		
28	<u>not include solid waste collection vehicles, compactors,</u>		
29	<u>graders, or other earthmoving equipment.</u>
