This act shall take effect upon becoming a law. б HOUSE SUMMARY Authorizes the Department of Citrus to adopt a rule listing the forms used in conducting its business. Allows the Florida Citrus Commission to prescribe by rule that a producer contract must contain information that the commission considers necessary for the protection of the producer from deceptive practices. Authorizes the Florida Citrus Commission to make general reference to national or state requirements in its rules relating to issuance and use of symbols, certification marks, service marks, or trademarks if a license applicant would be required to comply with those requirements regardless of the Department of Citrus' action with respect to issuance of the license applied for.
