Funds shall be credited to the trust fund as provided in 21 s. 411.01, to be used for the purposes of the Florida 22 Partnership for Children First, Inc., as set forth therein. 23 (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 216.301 and 24 pursuant to s. 216.351, any balance in the trust fund at the 25 26 end of any fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund at the end of the year and shall be available for carrying out the 27 28 purposes of the trust fund. 29 (3) Pursuant to the provisions of s. 19(f)(2), Art.

III of the State Constitution, the Children First School

Readiness Trust Fund shall, unless terminated sooner, be

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terminated on July 1, 2002. Prior to its scheduled termination, the trust fund shall be reviewed as provided in s. 215.3206(1) and (2). Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1998, if Committee Substitute for House Bills 683 and 2131 or similar legislation creating the Florida Partnership for Children First, Inc., is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension thereof.
