"Engaged in the business" means a person who (d) devotes time, attention, and labor to dealing in firearms as a regular course of trade or business with the principal objective of livelihood and profit through the repetitive purchase and resale of firearms. The term does not include a person who makes occasional sales, exchanges, or purchases of firearms for the enhancement of a personal collection or for a hobby, or makes an occasional sale of all or part of a personal collection of firearms. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
