Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (4) of section 110.233, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

110.233 Political activities and unlawful acts prohibited.--

(4) As an individual, each employee retains all rights and obligations of citizenship provided in the Constitution and laws of the state and the Constitution and laws of the United States. However, no employee in the career service shall:

(a) Hold, or be a candidate for, public office while in the employment of the state or take any active part in a political campaign while on duty or within any period of time during which the employee is expected to perform services for which he or she receives compensation from the state. However, when authorized by his or her agency head and approved by the

1 Department of Management Services as involving no interest
 2 which conflicts or activity which interferes with his or her
