Alternative Education Institute to the State of Florida.

(2) The Department of Management Services is

- (2) The Department of Management Services is authorized to direct change orders in any existing construction contracts, provide site inspection services, and provide any other administrative services necessary to complete the construction of the facility. The Department of Management Services shall have access to all state funds previously appropriated to the Alternative Education Institute for this purpose.
 - (3) Students served in the facility must:
- (a) Reside in Hillsborough County, Pinellas County,

 Manatee County, Polk County, or any other county that enters

 into an agreement with the Department of Juvenile Justice and
 the Hillsborough County School Board.
 - (b) Not have been adjudicated.
- (c) Be at risk, as defined in the cooperative agreement.
- (4) Funding for the residential component of the program offered at the facility must be provided through appropriations to the Department of Juvenile Justice. Funding for the education component of the program offered at the facility must be provided through the Florida Education Finance Program.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

HOUSE SUMMARY

Provides that the educational facility authorized to be constructed by the Alternative Education Institute shall be designated as a residential public education facility operated by the Department of Juvenile Justice and the Hillsborough County School Board through cooperative agreement. Provides for transfer of ownership from the institute to the State of Florida and provides duties of the Department of Management Services. Provides student eligibility and funding.
