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I. FINAL ACTION STATUS:

HB 4577 passed the House on April 23, 1998; in the Senate was substituted for SB 2506 and passed on May 1, 1998. Became law without Governor's signature on May 30, 1998. Chapter Law 98-345.

This legislation re-creates the Correctional Work Program Trust Fund without modification. The Correctional Work Program Trust Fund is administered by the Department of Corrections.
