An act relating to trust funds; re-creating the
Florida Agricultural Exposition Trust Fund
within the Department of Corrections without
modification; carrying forward current balances
and continuing current sources and uses
thereof; providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the Legislature wishes to extend the life of
the Florida Agricultural Exposition Trust Fund within the
Department of Corrections, which is otherwise scheduled to be
terminated pursuant to constitutional mandate, and

WHEREAS, the Legislature has reviewed the Florida
Agricultural Exposition Trust Fund within the Department of
Corrections before its scheduled termination date and has
found that it continues to meet an important public purpose,
and

WHEREAS, the Legislature has found that existing public
policy concerning the Florida Agricultural Exposition Trust
Fund within the Department of Corrections sets adequate
parameters for its use, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. The Florida Agricultural Exposition Trust
Fund within the Department of Corrections, SAMAS number
702298, which is to be terminated pursuant to Section 19(f),
Article III of the State Constitution on November 4, 2000, is
re-created.

Section 2. All current balances of the Florida
Agricultural Exposition Trust Fund within the Department of
