13	WHEREAS, the Legislature has reviewed the Child Support
14	Trust Fund within the Justice Administrative Commission before
15	its scheduled termination date and has found that it continues
16	to meet an important public purpose, and
17	WHEREAS, the Legislature has found that existing public
18	policy concerning the Child Support Trust Fund within the
19	Justice Administrative Commission sets adequate parameters for
20	its use, NOW, THEREFORE,
21	
22	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

24	Section 1. The Child Support Trust Fund within the
25	Justice Administrative Commission, SAMAS number 212084, which
26	is to be terminated pursuant to Section 19(f), Article III of
27	the State Constitution on November 4, 2000, is re-created.
28	Section 2. <u>All current balances of the Child Support</u>
29	Trust Fund within the Justice Administrative Commission are
30	carried forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust
31	fund are continued.
