## I. FINAL ACTION STATUS:

HB 4595 passed the House on April 23, 1998; in the Senate was substituted for SB 2430 and passed on May 1, 1998. Became law without Governor's signature on May 30, 1998. Chapter Law 98-354.

## II. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the State Attorney's Forfeiture and Investigative Trust Fund without modification. The State Attorney's Forfeiture and Investigative Trust Fund is administered by the Justice Administration Commission.

#### III. SUBSTANTIVE RESEARCH:

#### A. PRESENT SITUATION:

1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

Section 27.3451, F.S., creates the trust fund

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The Legislature hereby re-creates the Forfeiture and Investigative Trust Fund which will appropriate \$487,946. These funds will be divided proportionally to all State Attorney's Offices under the Justice Administration Commission.

MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

Revenues received by a State Attorney as a result of forfeiture proceedings, shall be deposited in the Forfeiture and Investigative Trust Fund for the investigation of crime, prosecution of criminals, or other law enforcement purposes.
