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I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Grants and Donations Trust Fund without modification. The Grants and Donations Trust Fund is administered by the Justice Administration Commission.

II. SUBSTANTIVE RESEARCH:

A. PRESENT SITUATION:

1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

The Grants and Donations Trust Fund was created by the Administration Commission.

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The receipts of the Grants and Donations Trust Fund are expended for federal and state grants and miscellaneous operational expenses of the department. The 1998-1999 fiscal year appropriation is \$19,943,064.

3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The primary sources of revenue for the Grants and Donations Trust Fund are state grants. The receipts include funds for state attorney and public defender training, food stamp fraud administration, and funds for transfers.

B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.
