I. FINAL ACTION STATUS:

HB 4601 passed the House on April 23, 1998; in the Senate was substituted for SB 2458 and passed on May 1, 1998. Became law without Governor's signature on May 30, 1998. Chapter Law 98-357.

This legislation re-creates the Administration Trust Fund without modification. The Administration Trust Fund is administered by the Department of Juvenile Justice.
