I. FINAL ACTION STATUS:

HB 4607 passed the House on April 23, 1998; in the Senate was substituted for SB 2466 and passed on May 1, 1998. Became law without Governor's signature on May 30, 1998. Chapter Law 98-360.

This legislation re-creates the Social Services Block Grant Trust Fund without modification. The Social Services Block Grant Trust Fund is administered by the Department of Juvenile Justice.
