A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to trust funds; re-creating the  
Social Services Block Grant Trust Fund within  
the Department of Juvenile Justice without  
modification; carrying forward current balances  
and continuing current sources and uses  
thereof; providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the Legislature wishes to extend the life of  
the Social Services Block Grant Trust Fund within the  
Department of Juvenile Justice, which is otherwise scheduled  
to be terminated pursuant to constitutional mandate, and

WHEREAS, the Legislature has reviewed the Social  
Services Block Grant Trust Fund within the Department of  
Juvenile Justice before its scheduled termination date and has  
found that it continues to meet an important public purpose,  
and

WHEREAS, the Legislature has found that existing public  
policy concerning the Social Services Block Grant Trust Fund  
within the Department of Juvenile Justice sets adequate  
parameters for its use, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. The Social Services Block Grant Trust Fund  
within the Department of Juvenile Justice, SAMAS number  
802639, which is to be terminated pursuant to Section 19(f),  
Article III of the State Constitution on November 4, 2000, is  
re-created.

Section 2. All current balances of the Social Services  
Block Grant Trust Fund within the Department of Juvenile

1 Justice are carried forward, and all current sources and uses  
2 of the trust fund are continued.

3 Section 3. This act shall take effect November 4,  
4 2000.
