# I. FINAL ACTION STATUS:

HB 4609 passed the House on April 23, 1998; in the Senate was substituted for SB 2462 and passed on May 1, 1998. Became law without Governor's signature on May 30, 1998. Chapter Law 98-361.

This legislation re-creates the Juvenile Crime Prevention and Early Intervention Trust Fund without modification. The Juvenile Crime Prevention and Early Intervention Trust Fund is administered by the Department of Juvenile Justice.
