I. FINAL ACTION STATUS:

HB 4631 passed the House on April 23, 1998; in the Senate was substituted for SB 2396 and passed on May 1, 1998. Became law without Governor's signature on May 30, 1998. Chapter Law 98-372.

II. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Grants and Donations Trust Fund without modification. The Grants and Donations Trust Fund is administered by the Department of Legal Affairs.

A. PRESENT SITUATION:

1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

The Grants and Donations Trust Fund was created by the Administration Commission.

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The receipts of the Grants and Donations Trust Fund are expended for state and federal grants received by the Department of Legal Affairs and miscellaneous operational expenses. The 1998-1999 fiscal year appropriation is \$6,353,523.

3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The primary sources of revenue are federal and state grants.
