I. FINAL ACTION STATUS:

HB 4649 passed the House on April 23, 1998; in the Senate was substituted for SB 2494 and passed on May 1, 1998. Became law without Governor's signature on May 30, 1998. Chapter Law 98-381.

II. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Grants and Donations Trust Fund without modification. The Grants and Donations Trust Fund is administered by the State Courts System.

III. SUBSTANTIVE RESEARCH:

A. PRESENT SITUATION:

1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

The Grants and Donations Trust Fund was created by the Administration Commission.

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The receipts of the Grants and Donations Trust Fund are expended for state and federal grants received by the State Courts System and miscellaneous operational expenses. The 1998-1999 fiscal year appropriation is \$1,012,186.

MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The Supreme Court periodically receives federal grants directly from federal grantees such as the State Justice Institute and miscellaneous state grants from grantees such as the Florida Bar.
