The department may 21 22 deposit into the trust fund receipts and revenues received as a result of federal criminal, administrative, or civil 23 forfeiture proceedings and receipts and revenues received from 24 federal asset-sharing programs. The trust fund is exempt from 25 26 the service charges imposed by s. 215.20. (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 216.301 and 27 28 pursuant to s. 216.351, any balance in the trust fund at the 29 end of any fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund at the end of the year and shall be available for carrying out the 30

purposes of the trust fund.

III of the State Constitution, the trust fund shall, unless terminated sooner, be terminated on July 1, 2002. Prior to its scheduled termination, the trust fund shall be reviewed as provided in s. 215.3206(1) and (2).

- (5) If the seizing agency is a state agency, all remaining proceeds shall be deposited into the General Revenue Fund. However, if the seizing agency is:
- (a) The Department of Law Enforcement, the proceeds accrued pursuant to the provisions of the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act shall be deposited into the Forfeiture and Investigative Support Trust Fund as provided in s. 943.362 or into the department's Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund as provided in s. 943.365, as applicable.

Section 3. Subsection (1) of section 943.362, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

943.362 Forfeiture and Investigative Support Trust Fund.--

(1) There is created the Forfeiture and Investigative Support Trust Fund into which the department may deposit revenues received as a result of state or federal criminal proceedings, other than revenues deposited into the department's Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund under s. 943.365.
