**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 19, between lines 2 and 3,

insert:

Section 10. Subsection (8) is added to section 373.406, Florida Statutes, to read:

373.406 Exemptions.--The following exemptions shall apply:

(8) Certified aquaculture activities which apply appropriate best management practices adopted pursuant to s. 597.004 are exempt from this part.

Section 11. Subsection (5) is added to section 403.0885, Florida Statutes, to read:

403.0885 Establishment of federally approved state National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Program.--

(5) Certified aquaculture activities under s. 597.004 that have individual production units whose annual production and water discharge are less than the parameters established
