An act relating to trust funds; creating s. 570.205, F.S.; creating the Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund within the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services; providing for sources of funds; exempting the trust fund from various service charges; providing for annual carryforward of funds; providing for future review and termination or re-creation of the trust fund; amending s. 932.7055, F.S., relating to duties of the department with respect to the deposit of certain moneys, to conform; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 570.205, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

570.205 Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund.--

- (1) The Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund is created within the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services. The department may deposit into the trust fund receipts and revenues received as a result of federal criminal, administrative, or civil forfeiture proceedings and receipts and revenues received from federal asset-sharing programs. The trust fund is exempt from the service charges imposed by s. 215.20.
- (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 216.301 and pursuant to s. 216.351, any balance in the trust fund at the end of any fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund at the

end of the year and shall be available for carrying out the 1 2 purposes of the trust fund. 3 (3) Pursuant to the provisions of s. 19(f)(2), Art. 4 III of the State Constitution, the trust fund shall, unless 5 terminated sooner, be terminated on July 1, 2002. Prior to its 6 scheduled termination, the trust fund shall be reviewed as 7 provided in s. 215.3206(1) and (2). Section 2. Paragraph (i) of subsection (5) of section 8 9 932.7055, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 932.7055 Disposition of liens and forfeited 10 11 property.--12 (5) If the seizing agency is a state agency, all remaining proceeds shall be deposited into the General Revenue 13 14 However, if the seizing agency is: 15 (i) The Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, the proceeds accrued pursuant to the provisions of 16 the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act shall be deposited into 17 18 the Agricultural Law Enforcement Trust Fund or into the 19 department's Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund as provided in 20 s. 570.205, as applicable. 21 Section 3.
