Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 32, between lines 20 and 21,

insert:

Section 36. Paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of section 73.092, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

73.092 Attorney's fees.--

(1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, the court, in eminent domain proceedings, shall award attorney's fees based solely on the benefits achieved for the client.

(c) Attorney's fees based on benefits achieved shall be awarded in accordance with the following schedule:

1. ~~Twenty-five~~ ~~Thirty-three~~ percent of any benefit up to \$250,000; plus

2. ~~Twenty~~ ~~Twenty-five~~ percent of any portion of the benefit between \$250,000 and \$1 million; plus

3. Fifteen ~~Twenty~~ percent of any portion of the benefit exceeding \$1 million.
