plan, tuition-reimbursement plan, career-path program, health insurance, life insurance, and disability benefits may not be substantially reduced, except in the case of exigent operational necessity. (3) (4) Nothing in this act shall preclude the sheriff from enhancing those benefits and emoluments for employees and б appointees of the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office. (4) Nothing in this act shall be construed as affecting the budget-making authority and power of the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
