Section 3. Section 7 of chapter 74-423, Laws of Florida, as amended by chapter 76-323, is amended to read:

Section 7. Purchases.--All purchases or leases of supplies, equipment, materials, or office space for use in the operation and maintenance of the district in excess of \$5,000 \$1,000 shall be approved by the board only after competitive bids shall have been sought from at least three different sources of supply. However, if less than three different sources are available, competitive bids shall be accepted from whatever sources are available. During emergencies, the board may, by resolution, authorize the purchase or lease of designated supplies and equipment in excess of the above mentioned limitations without competitive bidding.

Section 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared severable.

Section 5. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
