high school shall be exempt from any special assessment levied by a municipality to fund emergency medical services. As used in this subsection, "religious institution" means any church, synagogue, or other established physical place for worship at which nonprofit religious services and activities are regularly conducted and carried on. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
