A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to concurrency on the Florida  
Interstate Highway System; amending s.  
163.3180, F.S.; directing the Department of  
Transportation to lower the level-of-service  
standard on certain segments of the system  
within the jurisdiction of a local government  
under certain circumstances; providing an  
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (10) of section 163.3180,  
Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

163.3180 Concurrency.--

(10)(a) With regard to facilities on the Florida  
Intrastate Highway System as defined in s. 338.001, local  
governments shall adopt the level-of-service standard  
established by the Department of Transportation by rule. For  
all other roads on the State Highway System, local governments  
shall establish an adequate level-of-service standard that  
need not be consistent with any level-of-service standard  
established by the Department of Transportation.

(b) At the request of local government, the Department  
of Transportation shall lower the level-of-service standard  
one letter grade on any segment of the Florida Interstate  
Highway System which is within the requesting local  
government's jurisdiction if:

1. The road segment is required to meet a B  
level-of-service standard under Department of Transportation  
rules; and
