A bill to be entitled
An act relating to public school parental
choice; amending s. 228.057, F.S.; requiring
school districts with a controlled open
enrollment program to afford unrestricted
access to the program to parents of students in
multiple session schools; providing an
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (8) is added to section 228.057,
Florida Statutes, 1996 Supplement, to read:

228.057 Public school parental choice.--

(8) Notwithstanding any provision of this section, a
school district with schools operating on both multiple
session schedules and single session schedules shall afford
parents of students in multiple session schools unrestricted
and immediate access to the controlled open enrollment program
of the school district.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July, 1, 1997.

HOUSE SUMMARY

Requires school districts that offer a controlled open
enrollment program and have schools on both multiple and
single session schedules to afford parents of students in
multiple session schools unrestricted access to the
controlled open enrollment program.
