Paragraph (q) is added to subsection (1) of 10 section 236.081, Florida Statutes, to read: 11 236.081 Funds for operation of schools.--If the annual 12 allocation from the Florida Education Finance Program to each district for operation of schools is not determined in the 13 14 annual appropriations act or the substantive bill implementing the annual appropriations act, it shall be determined as 15 16 follows: (1) COMPUTATION OF THE BASIC AMOUNT TO BE INCLUDED FOR 17 OPERATION. -- The following procedure shall be followed in 18 19 determining the annual allocation to each district for 20 operation: 21 (q) Extended school year.--Each school district that 22 provides for an extended school year shall receive an 23 allocation for such extension for one-half of the cost of operation of schools for up to 6 extra school days per year. 24 25 For purposes of this paragraph, the extension must be beyond 180 days of regular classroom instruction in the typical 26 27 school year. The cost of operation shall be based on a pro 28 rata share of each school district's operational budget for 29 the previous year divided by the number of classroom teaching 30 days. 31

HOUSE SUMMARY б Provides that each school district that extends its school year beyond 180 days of regular classroom instruction in a typical school year shall receive an allocation for such extension for one-half of the cost of operation of schools for up to 6 extra school days per yēar.
