23	immobilization or impoundment of the vehicle, the registered
24	owner and all persons having a recorded lien against the
25	<u>vehicle</u> telephone any lessor or lienholder before 5 p.m. on
26	the business day after the day that the vehicle has been
27	impounded or immobilized. A lessor, rental car company, or
28	lienholder may then obtain the vehicle, upon payment of any
29	lawful towing or storage charges. If the vehicle is a rental
30	vehicle subject to a written contract, the charges may be
31	separately charged to the renter, in addition to the rental

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rate, along with other separate fees, charges, and recoupments disclosed on the rental agreement. If the storage facility fails to provide timely notice to a lessor, rental car company, or lienholder as required by this paragraph, the storage facility shall be responsible for payment of any towing or storage charges necessary to release the vehicle to a lessor, rental car company, or lienholder that accrue after the notice period, which charges may then be assessed against the driver of the vehicle if the vehicle was lawfully impounded or immobilized.
