A bill to be entitled

An act relating to license plates; amending s. 324.202, F.S.; including Duval and Orange Counties within a list of counties in which the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles shall implement a pilot project to determine the effectiveness of using recovery agents for the seizure of license plates; providing for a report by a certain date; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 324.202, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

324.202 Seizure of motor vehicle license plates by recovery agents.--

(1) The Department of Highway Safety and Motor
Vehicles shall implement a pilot project in Broward County,
Dade County, <u>Duval County</u>, and <u>Hillsborough County</u>, and <u>Orange County</u> to determine the effectiveness of using recovery agents for the seizure of license plates. On <u>October 1</u>, 1998,
October 1, 1996, the department shall provide a report to the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of
Representatives, the chair of the Senate Commerce Committee,
the chair of the House Insurance Committee, and the Majority and Minority Leaders of the Senate and the House of
Representatives, on the results of the pilot project. Licensed recovery agents and recovery agencies as described in s.
493.6101(20) and (21) may seize license plates of motor vehicles whose registrations have been suspended pursuant to

s. 316.646 or s. 627.733 in such counties upon compliance with this section and rules of the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
