Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 29 30 law.

LEGISLATIVE SUMMARY Prohibits persons, partnerships, limited liability companies, or corporations from using a fictitious name in the conduct of business with an intent to misrepresent the geographic origin or location of such person or entity. Any person who violates the prohibition is guilty of a second degree misdemeanor and may not maintain any court action until compliance is made.
