627.6472 Exclusive provider organizations.--

exclusive provider shall provide coverage for charges for general anesthesia or hospitalization for dental care provided to a covered person who is a minor, is severely disabled, or has a medical condition requiring hospitalization or general anesthesia for dental care treatment. Such contract may require prior authorization for hospitalization for dental care procedures in the same manner that the provider requires prior authorization for hospitalization for other covered diseases or conditions.

Section 4. Section 627.65755, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

627.65755 Coverage for dental procedures; anesthesia and hospitalization.--Each group, blanket, or franchise health insurance policy sold in this state shall provide coverage for charges for general anesthesia or hospitalization for dental care provided to a covered person who is a minor, is severely disabled, or has a medical condition requiring hospitalization or general anesthesia for dental care treatment. The insurer issuing such policy may require prior authorization for

hospitalization for dental care procedures in the same manner that the insurer requires prior authorization for 2 3 hospitalization for other covered diseases or conditions. Section 5.
