Section 1. Present paragraph (r) of subsection (1) of section 944.09, Florida Statutes, is redesignated as paragraph (s), and a new paragraph (r) is added to that subsection to read:

(1) The department shall adopt rules governing the administration of the correctional system and the operation of the department, which rules shall relate to:

The purchase of items from the commissary or canteen by inmates. The department shall prohibit an inmate from purchasing items from the commissary or canteen which are contrary to any restricted or therapeutic diet prescribed for that inmate by a physician and which may risk the health of the inmate. Purchases that may be prohibited include, but need

not be limited to, candy, chocolate, tobacco, and other food or nonfood items. The department shall monitor the purchases made by each inmate for whom a restricted or therapeutic diet is prescribed. If an inmate makes a prohibited purchase, the department shall add an additional 100 days to the inmate's sentence. Section 2.
